

Sowing instructions Black Radish

Outdoor sowing: middle of June - beginning of September

Germination: 6 - 10 days

Germination temp.: 10 - 18 °C

Sowing depth: 1/2 - 1 cm

Plant distance: 15 - 25 cm

Distance in rows: 25 - 35 cm

Soil conditions: sandy and loamy

Plant position: sunny

Days till harvest: 60

Sow small amounts each time You sow, because this radish variety gets a lot bigger than other varieties. Sow outdoors from the middle of June till the beginning of September. Sow thinly and sparsely and cover the seeds with a thin layer of soil. Keep about 10 - 15 cm between the seeds. And about 25 cm between the rows.

Thin the seedlings to 15 - 20 cm apart, when they're large enough to handle. For a continuous harvest: sow small amounts every 2-3 weeks. Don't use to much fertilizer because too much feeding can cause rotting.
